Sunday, December 18, 2022, 2 P.M. - 4 P.M.

Admit Card and Preferences for Admission to NLUs

1. The candidates appearing for the Common Law Admission Test (“CLAT”) 2023 for admission to Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes at National Law Universities (NLUs) may indicate their admission preferences to the NLUs and download their Admit Card from **6:00 pm, December 6, 2022** until **11:59 pm, December 17, 2022**.
2. It is mandatory for the candidates to fill their admission preferences to the NLUs before downloading their Admit Card for the CLAT 2023.
3. Candidates may update their preferences for admission to NLUs anytime before 11:59 pm, December 17, 2022. Any requests for a change in preferences for admission to NLUs after 11:59 pm on December 17, 2022 will not be accommodated.
4. Candidates must fill a minimum of 5 (five) preferences. There is no outer limit to the number of preferences that may be filled.
5. Candidates will be considered for admission only to the NLUs filled by them in their preference form. For example: If a candidate has chosen only five NLUs, then they will be considered for allotment of seats only in those five NLUs and not to any other NLU. This will hold true even if:
 - a. Vacancies are available in other NLUs;
 - b. As per the merit list, the candidate has a higher rank than the cut-off list announced by NLUs not preferred by the Candidate.
6. Before filling the preference form for admission to NLUs, candidates must check the respective NLU’s brochure to confirm that they are eligible to apply for admission to the programme that they are filling in their preference list.

7. Candidates are requested to follow the steps given below to fill their preferences for admission to NLUs and download their Admit Card:
- a. Login to your CLAT account at <https://consortiumofnlus.ac.in/clat-2023/>
 - b. Click on **Update Preferences**
 - c. Fill the preferences as required and click the **Update Preferences** button.
 - d. Click on **Download Admit Card** button
